## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

1.Odisha Power Transmission Corporation Ltd (in short OPTCL), a deemed Transmission Licensee under Sec.14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 vested with operation and maintenance of State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC) vide Govt. Of Odisha Transfer Scheme, 2005, has submitted its Application to the Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission on 27.11.2020 for approval of Annual Revenue Requirement and Determination of Fees & Operating Charges for SLDC Functions for FY 2021-22. which has been registered as Case No.74/2020. The Public Notice along with the details of filing and relevant matters may be downloaded from the SLDC's website www.sldcorissa.org.in, OPTCL's website www.optcl.co.in as well as the OERC website www.orierc.org.

The full set of the Annual Revenue Requirement and Fees & Charges for SLDC Functions for FY 2021-22 can also be obtained by interested persons from the Offices of Sr.G.M (RT&C), OPTCL, the Chief Load Dispatcher, SLDC and all General Managers in charge of EHT O&M Circle of OPTCL on payment of the photocopying charges of Rs.50/- during the office hours on or before 18.01.2021. Interested parties may also inspect/peruse the details of filing in the office hours of the above office on the basis of plain paper application.

Suggestions/objections, if any, together with supporting materials may be filed before the Secretary, Odisha Electricity Regulatory Commission, Plot No.4, Chunakoli, Sailashree Vihar, Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar-751021 in person or through Registered Post including email/Courier Services only so as to reach him on or before 18.01.2021 positively. The suggestions/objections should be filed in seven copies and should carry full name and postal address with Postal Index Number (PIN) Code of the person/ organizations/ institutions along with E-mail ID & contact Telephone Number and shall be supported by an affidavit serving a copy to the undersigned. Only valid suggestions/objections and filed through affidavit within the time limit will be admitted for the hearing.

4. The date of hearing shall be duly published in the Newspapers and also communicated to the parties whose objections are admitted.

## DETAILS OF PROPOSED LEVY AND COLLECTION OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR SLDC **FUNCTIONS FOR FY 2021-22**

The Annual Charges for SLDC have been computed as per provision in OERC (Fees & Charges of State Load Despatch Centre and Other related matters) Regulations. 2010:

(A) The Details of Annual Charges which comprise of System Operation Charges (SOC) & Market Operation Charges (MOC) are given in the table below. (Rs in Lacs)

For the purpose of determination of the above charges for CGPs, the maximum MW scheduled during April to October 2020 has been considered. In absence of approved injection scheduled for some of the CGPs during the FY 2020-21 (upto October, 2020), the approved scheduled quantum for previous year has been considered for the purpose of levying SLDC charges. It is proposed to collect SLDC charges from industries importing power through Intra/Inter-State open access only for the month of their transaction basing on the maximum scheduled quantum.

## (B)Registration Fee:

Besides the above charges, provision for collection of registration fee@Rs.1.00 lac from all users has been made as per OERC Regulation. It is also proposed to collect registration fee from the industries who are importing power through Inter-State open access.

(C)Application Fee and Scheduling Charges:

Application fee and Scheduling charges shall be paid by the open access customers as per the OERC (Terms and Conditions of Intra-State Open Access) Regulations, 2020.
